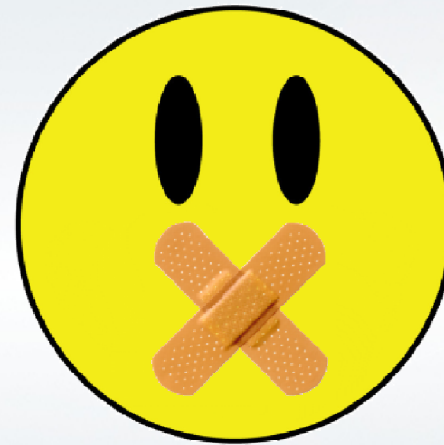
JAPAN
